REGULATIONS:

ENTRIES: Entry on the day, close at start. Helmets must be worn. Entries must be made on the official Entry Form. The entry fee of £18. Juniors £10 (includes a £1 "day" membership fee).

MACHINE ELIGIBILITY: The machines eligible for the event must conform to the current rules. In general all machines must utilise engine, frame, forks, gearbox and hubs manufactured of the period and be fitted with an efficient silencer.

COURSE: The course will be laid out at Upper Colegate Farm, Whittington and will comprise 10 sections to be completed over 4 laps. All sections will be laid out in the style of a trial in the 1960's. By kind permission of the Pritchett family.

X	monoshock not conforming to class E/H

Red/Blue	Pre-65	Harder route - Suitable for pre-65 and mono motorcycles
50/50	Pre-65	5 sections ride hard route, 5 sections ride easier route (marked at section start)
White	Novice	Easier Route - Suitable for novices and rigid motorcycles
Green	Gentleman	Suitable for newcomers or the rider of more mature years.
